



DRESS CODE

The dress code for Ealing Golf Club requires all guests to wear clothes specifically for golf or that comply with the following criteria

- TROUSERS** All types or colour of denim, paramilitary or camouflage style trousers, combat trousers or tracksuits are strictly prohibited on the golf course. Trousers must not be tucked into socks. Smart, denim trousers are **ONLY** allowed in the Spike Bar.
- SHORTS/SOCKS** Shorts **MUST** be tailored and worn with sports socks. Football, beach and running shorts are **NOT** acceptable.
- SHIRTS** Golf shirts must have collars and sleeves. T-shirts and vests are not allowed on the golf course. Rugby or football style shirts are also prohibited. Smart, clean T-shirts are **ONLY** permitted in the Spike Bar.
- SHOES/HATS** **Shoes with soft spikes** designed for the purpose of playing golf only are permitted on the golf course. All other styles or types, such as trainers are prohibited. Golf shoes/trainers are **ONLY** permitted in the Spike Bar. Hats are **NOT** to be worn in the Clubhouse.
- LADIES** Ladies must conform to the essence, spirit and intent of the dress code.
- MOBILE PHONES** Mobile phones are permitted on the course for emergency use only and must be switched off. Mobile phones are allowed in the Clubhouse but we would ask Members and their guests to respect other people when using their phones.
- ENFORCEMENT** The General Manager, Professional and Staff are authorised by the Board of Directors to require any Member or visitor, whose dress does not comply with the dress code, to leave the course and/or the Clubhouse. Members who decline to comply with this code will be reported to the Membership Committee.
