# EALING GOLF CLUB – SOCIETY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

## 1. Booking and Confirmation

A booking is only confirmed once the non-refundable deposit is paid. A receipted invoice for the deposit will be issued. Exact Golf and catering numbers (including vegetarian requirements) must be confirmed **at least 10 days** prior to the date of the event to secure the correct number of tee times and catering. The club cannot guarantee to accommodate more players than originally booked. **Minimum numbers for Two-tee and Shot Gun starts will be applied.**

The Applicant is responsible for informing all participants of their obligation to abide by Ealing Golf Club rules and dress codes (see below)

## 2. Timings

Your reserved tee times and meal times are pre-arranged and therefore it is essential that these times be strictly adhered to. Tee times are every 10 minutes.

## 3. Cancellations

The deposit is non-refundable. Organisers are expected to advise Ealing Golf Club as early as possible if the numbers are likely to be different to those booked. Exact numbers must be confirmed at least 10 days before the event. After that date, cancellation of the whole event will incur 90% cancellation charge and a reduction in numbers in excess of 10% will be charged. There will be no charge for reductions in the total number of golfers / diners confirmed 10 days or more before the event up to 10% of the total numbers. Reductions in excess of 10% will be charged 100% cancellation charge.

## 4. Required Standards

Ealing is not a course for beginners: it is a challenging course and the River Brent features on 10 holes. Guests who are not competent golfers will not enjoy the day and will hold up play. Each player must be able to play to a reasonable standard, have his/her own set of golf clubs, proper golf shoes and attire and is expected to adhere to the normal etiquette of golf.

## 5. Damage

The Client, in accepting these Terms and Conditions assumes responsibility for any and all damage caused by him/her or any member of the party, whether in rooms reserved or in any part of the Clubhouse or grounds.

## 6. Cancellation by Ealing Golf Club Ltd

The Club reserves the right to cancel or amend any reservations:

- a) If the Club or any part of it is closed due to fire, natural disaster, employee dispute, alteration, demolition, decoration or by order of any public authority.
- b) If the Client becomes insolvent or enters into liquidation or receivership.
- c) If the reservation is potentially detrimental to the reputation of the Club.
- d) If inclement weather causes the cancellation of a golf event the Club will refund any deposit made, but will have no further liability to the Client.

## 7. Dress Code – Course & Clubhouse

Shoes: All payers must wear soft spike golf shoes

Trousers / Shorts: Denim, combat trousers and tracksuits are not allowed. Trousers must not be tucked into socks. Shorts must be tailored (with zip or button fly) and worn with sports socks.

Shirts: Golf shirts must have collars and sleeves. Rugby / Football style shirts, T-shirts and vests are not allowed.

Ladies: Ladies must conform to the essence, spirit and intent of the dress code.

In the Clubhouse: Hats (except religious headwear) may not be worn. Golf shoes and casual clothing are permitted in the Spike Bar. In the Dining Room, smart casual clothing is required (no jeans) although groups playing more than 18 holes are not required to change for lunch.

## 9. Mobile Phones

Mobile phones must be switched off on the course. Considerate use of mobile phones is allowed in the Clubhouse.
