

EALING GOLF CLUB – MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

Benefits of Golf Membership

- Use of the Course and practice areas plus the Clubhouse
- Lockers, bags and trolley storage
- Complimentary golfers' liability insurance
- 20% discount on food & drinks purchased on swipe card (without any compulsory levy)
- Complimentary Associate membership for your partner, enabling them to use the social facilities and have their own swipe card to enjoy the 20% discount on food and drink
- Members' Guest Fees allowing your Guests to visit at reduced Green Fees
- Free room hire for a private function, subject to availability
- Complimentary County Card, providing discounted green fees at participating clubs throughout England.

Membership Options

7 Day Membership

- Use of the golf course and all facilities on all days of the week
- Eligible to play in all Club competitions and matches

Weekday Plus Membership

- Use of the golf course Monday – Friday plus at Weekends after 2pm from 1st April - 31st October and after 12.30pm from 1st Nov - 31st March.
- Use of all other facilities 7 days a week
- Eligible to play in medals, stablefords, roll-ups and club matches at entitled times (but not eligible for any match play competitions)

4 Day Membership

- Use of the golf course Monday – Thursday only
- Use of all other facilities 7 days a week
- Eligible to play in medals, stablefords, roll-ups and club matches at entitled times but not eligible for any match play competitions

Young Adult - As 7-day Membership

Junior Membership

- Use of the golf course Monday – Friday plus at Weekends after 1pm from 1st April - 31st October and after 12 noon from 1st Nov - 31st March.
- Use of all other facilities 7 days a week
- Eligible to play in all Junior competitions (& adult competitions as per Competitions Bye-law 5.1)

Country Membership

- For people who reside over 50 miles away from the Club
- Eligible to play a maximum of 12 times per year, 7 days a week.
- Not eligible to play in any competitions or matches

Procedure for Becoming a Member

- Complete a Membership application form and send to the Club. If you do not know a Member who can propose you, please contact the General Manager who can make arrangements
- You will be contacted to arrange an interview with the Selection Committee and, for applicants who do not have a current handicap, you may be asked to play with a senior Member of the club
- Following the interview, Club Rules require your application to be posted on the Club notice board for a minimum of 10 days
- The General Manager will contact you on completion of the application process
- Membership commences on payment of the appropriate Joining Fee and Subscription

* The Joining Fee shown is payable on joining. If preferred, it can be paid over 2 years at a 25% supplement (eg for 7 day, the fee would be £1,000 paid in two instalments of £500).

** The partner of an existing Golf Member does not pay a Joining Fee and where more than 1 person joins together; there may be special arrangements.

*** Young Adults joining aged 25 or more may be charged a pro-rata Joining Fee on becoming a Full Member

Rules

Men and Lady Members at Ealing Golf Club have equal rights. The Club Rules and Bye-laws are provided at interview or available in advance on request. These rules are designed to set standards of conduct and behaviour to ensure any Member may feel comfortable using any facility of the Club at any time.

The Dress Code requires all players to wear soft spike golf shoes and appropriate clothing on the course. Golf and casual clothing are permitted in the Spike Bar. For certain events, smart clothing (jacket and tie) is required.

Mobile phones must be switched off on the course. Considerate use of mobile phones is allowed in the Clubhouse.

Guests

Members may bring guests on twelve occasions per year. The host Member must play golf with the guest(s) and is responsible for the conduct and dress code of the guest(s) whilst at the Club.

Members' Guest Green Fees are:

Monday – Friday:	£20
Saturday & Sunday, after 12 noon:	£25
Twilight, after 5.00 pm:	£12.50 (if Pro Shop closed, Green Fee must be paid in advance in the Bar before playing)

There may be special offers from time to time and these will be communicated to Members by email and via notice boards.

There is no fee for a Social Guest using the Clubhouse facilities accompanied by the Member.

Beginners
